Evidence: Dark Windows quote (Seuss 20).

Evidence: Scary roads quote (Seuss 35).

Evidence: Brains, feet, and direction quote (Seuss 2).

Evidence: Mountains quote (Seuss 44).

Expand: Unmarked streets symbolize unexpected occurrences.

Expand: Lighted windows represent what is familiar, and darkened windows symbolize unexpected situations.

Expand: The road between "hither" and "yon" symbolized a person's journey through life.

Expand: Worrying about what lies ahead can keep people from taking action.

Expand: The reference to brains encourages people to think the choices they make.

Expand: Feet symbolize the readiness to get moving.

Expand: The mountains symbolize obstacles that every person encounters in life.

Expand: The advice to get on your way remind people to get started.
